



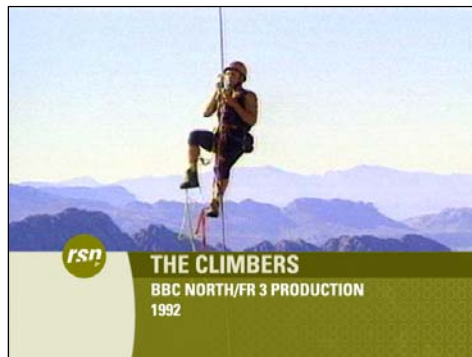
RSN Movie Nights | 'The Best of Banff'

As RSN's prime time programming, RSN Movie Nights showcases the best in feature-length outdoor films, from the award-winning segments in "The Best of Banff" to the finest ski racing in "Alpine Competition: Moments in Time" to legendary selections from the earliest outdoor films in "The Classics."

RSN Movie Nights | "The Best of Banff" spotlights films that have reached the pinnacle of their genre, a celebrated showcase at the annual Banff Mountain Film Festival, held in Banff, Alberta.

For 25 years, thousands of film fans from around the globe have traveled to Banff for the annual competition and festival. RSN provides the best seats in the house as host Peter Whittaker takes a selection of these inspiring adventure films and shares them with viewers in the comfort of their own home or hotel room.

Forty films from the Banff Mountain Film Festival will air on RSN this season, including "Oceans of Fear," a South African tale of rock climbing and B.A.S.E. jumping; "The Mountains of Yesterday," a Spanish documentary of the effort to conquer the infamous peak The Cigar; "True Fans," an epic 100 day cross-country bicycle trek; "Free Climbing the Nose," in which climber Lynn Hill tells her record breaking story; "118 Days in Captivity of Ice," a spectacular portrayal of the rigors of an Arctic Circle crossing; and "Everest - Sea to Summit," an Australian's incredible trek up Mt. Everest without supplemental oxygen.



Peter Whittaker is a new host of RSN Movie Nights | "The Best of Banff," coming to RSN with a strong background in both television and mountaineering. Peter has hosted the Emmy-nominated series "Trailside: Make Your Own Adventure" on PBS as well as numerous programs for the Outdoor Life Network. An early climber, Peter summited Mt. Rainier at age 12 and has since then led trips all over the world including a group of breast cancer survivors to South America's highest mountain and the oldest man and woman to the top of Mt. Vinson in Antarctica. Peter is the son of Lou Whittaker, leader of numerous Himalayan expeditions, and the nephew of Jim Whittaker, the first American to summit Everest (1963).
